Support Operation Red Nose Langley-Surrey by Volunteering!

Operation Red Nose is a 100% Volunteer operated FREE driving service that provides SAFE rides for clients, in their own vehicles, on specific nights during the Christmas Season.

There are many ways to volunteer with Operation Red Nose! We need drivers and navigators! Teams of three will head out on calls to get our clients home safely! Sign up as an individual or team. Sign up for one night.... sign up for them all! Such a rewarding experience for everyone involved.

IMPORTANT DETAILS TO KNOW ABOUT HOW VOLUNTEERING WORKS

Volunteers meet at our Headquarters after 8pm on the nights of operation to enjoy some food, training and fun with the other volunteers. Individual volunteers or teams are welcome! The Operation Red Nose Volunteer Coordinator will form teams of three including a Designated Driver (age 21+), an Escort Driver (age 19+) and a Navigator (age 19+).

Teams are dispatched as requests for rides are received. Once the team meets the client, the Designated Driver and the Navigator will drive the client(s) in their own vehicle with the Escort Driver following behind. After reaching the requested destination (which may include a drive through MacDonalds!) the team is reunited. The Navigator contacts Dispatch and they are off on their next call.

How to become a Operation Red Nose Volunteer in three easy steps...

STEP 1:

Complete the 2019 Operation Red Nose Volunteer Application Form, as attached.

STEP 2:

STEP 3:

Visit the RCMP in-person at either the main detachment or one of the community offices to complete and submit the RCMP's Consent for Disclosure of Criminal Record Information Form. You must show proof of identification.

When filling out the form at the detachment, in section two, when you are asked who your personal information is to be disclosed to, please write "Operation Red Nose Langley-Surrey". It is not necessary to name a specific person and no address is needed. Once processed, the RCMP will provide you with a copy of your criminal record check and you will need to submit to ORN or bring it with you on the night of your first shift.

**If you are uncertain of the exact date that you will be volunteering, we encourage you to attend the RCMP before November 15th, or as soon as possible, to allow the RCMP sufficient tie to process your form. In most cases they will be able to provide directly to you at your visit.

 - Confidentiality : All information about Operation Red Nose clients and volunteers that is disclosed to me will remain confidential and will not be used for any purpose other than to fulfill the mandate conferred upon me. I will also not discuss any details with other volunteers that could be used to identify a client or volunteer.
 - Courtesy : I will show patience and courtesy toward clients at all times.
 - Free service : Operation Red Nose is a free service. I will never solicit donations, but if clients wish to make a donation, I will thank them.
 - Fatigue : Operation Red Nose volunteers must often deal with fatigue, and its effects at night must not be underestimated. Therefore, I will not overestimate my capabilities and, if necessary, I will take a nap before reporting for duty as an Operation Red Nose volunteer.
 - Mutual respect : All Operation Red Nose volunteers, whether they work in the headquarters or on the road, deserve my full respect and consideration.
- \rightarrow return to Operation Red Nose all amounts given to me (donations, tips, gifts, etc.)

If I do not honour my commitment, Operation Red Nose reserves the right to terminate my participation as a volunteer for the current and future campaigns. The decision of Operation Red Nose is final.
